1:40pm Supporting the power system through Winter 2023

> The system operator has highlighted a tight supply situation from Winter 2023, driven in part by the changing nature of the power system as it transitions to a low carbon future. The Electricity Authority and the system operator have worked together to implement 4 initiatives ahead of Winter 2023 to improve market information and resource visibility. Longer term, work such as the demand side initiatives implemented as part of the real time pricing project, the Future Security and Resilience work programme, MDAG 100% renewables and the regulatory settings for distribution networks will ensure that New Zealand will be in the best position to address the challenges of the future renewable power system.




